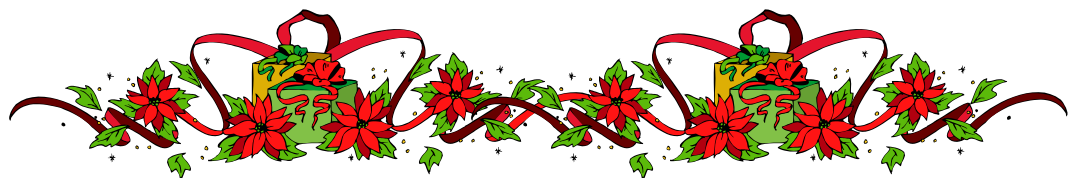

## MEMBER PROFILE: Jeff McBride

I joined BSC in 2004 to take advantage of the many trip opportunities offered by the club. My first trip was Aleyeska Alaska in March of 2005. I have been on one or two trips a year since then, only missing the 2010 season due to work commitments. I have been skiing since about 1975 and my first day skiing was Roundtop in PA where I was amazed to find out that I could not use my hiking boots to strap into the skis! In 1979 I also purchased and starting snowboarding. I can remember bringing my snowboard to the mountains and being allowed to snowboard, before they banned them and eventually started allowing them again in the late 1980's.

Since the late 70's I have both skied and snowboarded every year till about 1996 where I primarily switched to snowboarding, but as several members witnessed at the Vail / Beaver Creek trip this past winter, I did ski one day at Beaver Creek and enjoyed it very much.

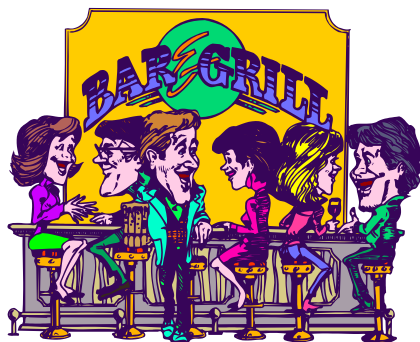

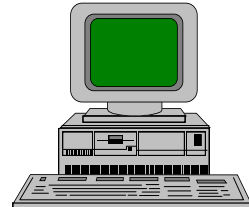
