Turkey...A trip back in time

On Friday, September 27th, members of the BSC and their friends (42 in all) departed from Dulles International Airport for a 9 day trip to Turkey. The group landed first in Istanbul and met our tour guide, Bahar Kahraman, who would be with us for the entire trip, and then flew to Izmir to begin our Turkish adventure. When we landed in Izmir we boarded our Mercedes coach and drove about an hour to Kusadasi. After a long day of travel, the group enjoyed a wonderful buffet dinner on the patio of our Cande Vista hotel which overlooked the beautiful Aegean Sea. Most went to bed after dinner in order to be rested for the next day.



After a sumptuous buffet breakfast Sunday morning, the group departed for a tour of the ancient city of Ephesus (as in Paul's Letter to the Ephesians and John's Revelation). This was a wonderful walk through history as we toured the ruins of this ancient city and learned about the daily lives of its citizens. The famous Terrace Houses with their magnificent mosaics and the amphitheater where Paul preached were just two highlights of our visit to this historic site. We also visited Sirence Village, a former Greek settlement but now inhabited by Turks. We enjoyed walking through the narrow streets, shopping at the small shops along the way and some even enjoyed having a meal at one of the many local restaurants.

The following day, the group visited the ruins of the Basilica of St. John and the House of the Virgin Mary (where Mary is said to have lived after the crucifixion of Jesus). Afterwards the group was treated to a 5 star lunch at Yedi Bilgeler, a local winery in Selcuk. The food, wine and staff were exceptional.



On Tuesday, our final day in the Izmir area, we traveled to the historic sites of Hierapolis and Pamukkale. We walked through the necropolis outside the ruins of Hierapolis, through the ruins of Hierapolis itself and then to Pamukkale. The underground water that once supplied Hierapolis now helps Pamukkale be one of the most important thermal centers in Turkey. This important site's hot springs flow from one to another and form breathtaking travertine "waterfalls." Some of the group enjoyed soaking in the ancient hot springs and some enjoyed walking barefoot down the travertine slope to meet the bus.

On Wednesday morning we left Kusadasi, drove to the airport at Izmir and flew back to Istanbul. As our rooms were not yet ready, our luggage was taken to the Orka Royal Hotel in the heart of the old city for us and we started our tour of this amazing city. The famous Blue Mosque and Hippodrome were visited and we were treated to a fabulous lunch of Turkish food and drinks at a local restaurant. The rest of day the group was left open so we could explore the city on our own.

On Thursday, we visited Hagia Sophia (once the 2nd largest church behind St. Peter's in Rome but now a museum), the Basilica Cistern (a source of water constructed in 532 AD) and for those who like to shop – the Grand Bazaar with its over 4000 shops. Many women on the trip said “Six hours is just not enough time to shop there!”.

On Friday, our final day of guided tours, we visited the Topkapi Palace complex (primary residence of the Ottoman Sultans for approximately 400 years)) and the Spice Market (Saffron is especially popular there). Afterwards we enjoyed a wonderful hour and a half boat ride on the Bosphorus gliding between Asia and Europe as Istanbul is a city that shares both continents.

Saturday was our final day in Istanbul to do and see whatever we wanted. Some went back to shop, others to the many museums in the area and still others to just enjoy daily life in Istanbul. You could not help but hear the call to prayer that rang out from the city's many mosques five times a day and served as a reminder of the city's Muslim heritage.

Side trips during our week included a visit to a ceramic workshop where we saw pottery being spun, decorated by hand, fired and available for sale as well as a carpet sales room where we learned about the various types of carpets and how they are made and valued. Beautiful ceramic gifts and even a few carpets were bought by members of our group who will treasure them as memories of their trip to Turkey.

Departing Istanbul on Sunday afternoon, we landed at Dulles International Airport late Sunday afternoon after an 11 hour flight. We were safe and secure and filled with many memories from our exciting time in Turkey.

Sno Mountain Files Bankruptcy

Sno Mountain, Pa., filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy in October. The state of Pennsylvania filed a lien against the area for \$516,503, most of which was for unpaid taxes. The area disputed the lien however, claiming that it only collected sales tax on rentals, so it did not owe taxes for all other sales.

Taos Gets New Lift

New Mexico's Taos Ski Valley added a beginner chairlift, The Pioneer Lift, and has expanded its tubing area, which will now open longer hours each day.

Killington Powering Lift with Cow Manure

Vermont's Killington Resort will power its K-1 Express Gondola during the 2012-13 season with electricity generated directly from cow manure from Vermont dairy farms through Killington's enrollment in Green Mountain Power's Cow Power program. Perfected over the last ten years, the process is very simple. Farms mix their cow manure it with wash water from the milking equipment which is pumped into an anaerobic digester for about three weeks at 100 degrees Fahrenheit. This allows bacteria to convert the manure into biogas, about 60% methane gas and 40% carbon dioxide and that goes into a modified natural gas engine, which drives an electric generator to create electricity to power the K-1 Express Gondola

Jay Peak Lowers Price of Lift Tickets

Jay Peak Resort announced a dramatic decrease in ticket prices made possible in part thanks to new revenue streams at the mountain, including The Pump House, Jay's massive indoor water park. A single-day lift ticket price has dropped from \$75 to \$64 for the 2012-13 season. Multi-day tickets also saw a price decrease of \$10 per day. Thus, a five-day pass will cost \$50 less than it did last season
