## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

### Greetings fellow BSC members!

I want to thank everyone for coming to our last meeting, especially our guest speakers, Bill Jones (no relation!) from SNOWEAST Magazine and Effie Rubinstein from Sports Tours, both of whom drove down from New Jersey.

We will be holding the 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Ski Expo at the November meeting. Vendors from local ski resorts and shops will be on hand.

With the weather getting cooler and winter around the corner, interest in skiing and our trips has been growing. Although some of our trips are now full and waitlisted, we still have a number of great trips available. If you are still undecided, then come to the November meeting and talk to the trip leaders and assistants and I'm sure you'll be able to find a trip that will suit you.

At the Blue Ridge Ski Council meeting this past spring, I was elected to coordinate the 2015 BRSC Winter Carnival at Mt. Bachelor. I just returned from the October BRSC meeting where I presented my evaluation of the 3 bids submitted for the trip. Representatives from ski clubs in the MD, VA & DC areas chose Dan Ellis from Winter Ski & Sports as the successful bidder. I am now in the process of assisting Dan in securing lodging for the trip and setting an itinerary for the whole group. Judging from the enthusiasm at the meeting (15 of the 27 BRSC member clubs have already signed on), I expect over 300 skiers from the Blue Ridge Ski Council to attend. Since this is the BRSC's first time at Mt. Bachelor, the town of Bend, Oregon will be rolling out the red carpet. Due to the lower cost and the variety of amenities associated with this trip, Mt Bachelor is sure to be an attractive destination for all of the clubs and I expect it will sell quickly. More information on this trip will be forthcoming.

If you have visited any of the ski swaps recently, you may have recognized some of our members there. We have been getting the word out about our Club by distributing information and talking to skiers who have attended these events held by local shops and resorts. We will continue our promotion efforts at the November ski swaps held at Ski Haus, Ski Roundtop, REI-Columbia, and Towson Armory. Although frost has not taken hold in our area yet, temperatures have been getting cooler. Ski season is just on the horizon. See you at the November Winter Expo!

## WORD OF THE DAY >>> Couloirs *kool-WAHR*

**noun**

DEFINITION: a steep mountainside gorge

EXAMPLES:

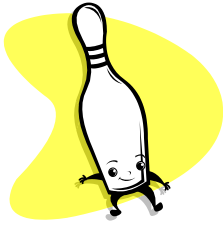
During our helicopter tour of the mountain range, we saw several snowboarders taking on the steep terrain of the *couloir*.

"Max and his father had a tough time getting to the top of El Diente Peak in the San Juan Mountains, resorting to ice axes and crampons to get through a *couloir* on the mountain." — from an article by John Aguilar in the *Daily Camera* (Boulder, Colorado), August 15, 2013



## DID YOU KNOW?

"Couloir" entered English in the 19th century from French, where it literally meant "passage." The term was originally applied specifically to steep gorges in the Alps and later to similar gorges elsewhere, especially ones used by skiers as passages down mountains. Because of their narrowness and steepness, couloirs can provide even expert skiers with some of the most challenging terrain they are likely to encounter—and they can be dangerous. In fact, journalist Jim Kochevar, writing of his experiences at the Telluride ski area for the *Chicago Tribune* in October 1997, declared (tongue in cheek) that "Couloir is French for 'cold, narrow place to die.'

## Wales to Scotland

Forty-three people went on our trip to Scotland this year. On Friday, September 20, the group left at 1:00 pm from the BWI Airport to Newark, New Jersey for an overnight flight to Manchester, England. Our personal driver, Lee, and his lovely wife, Sarah, met us at the airport and drove us to Chester.

We had a private tour of Chester's famous cathedral built in 1092 and its medieval shopping area, known as the Chester Rows. After a full day of touring, we had a typical English dinner at Toby's Carvery and went to our hotel for a well deserved rest.

The next day we were fully re-charged and ready to see Conwy Castle, located about an hour away in Wales. The castle was built in the late 1200s and was in near perfect condition providing great views over the city as well as the harbor. After the castle, we drove through the wonderful countryside of Wales and made stops along the way in the small towns of Llanberis and Betws-y-coed.

On Monday, we left Chester and headed to Liverpool where we visited the Walker Gallery, toured the Albert Docks area, and saw the Beatle's Story. Afterwards, everyone had time to visit the many museums and shops in the area.

On Tuesday, we traveled to York for a private



tour of the magnificent York Minster. York, which is a walled city, was the capital of the Roman Empire's northern territories for several hundred years, before falling under Viking control for a few hundred more years.

The next day we drove to Durham, which has a beautiful market, university, castle and a cathedral over 940 years old. We then crossed the border into Scotland and went to Melrose to see the ruins of Melrose Abbey. This border town, which saw many English invasions, finally took its toll under the rein of Henry VIII.

We stayed the next several nights in Edinburgh. On Thursday, we met our personal guide for the next 2 days and drove through the

beautiful Trossachs countryside to visit Stirling Castle. Next we drove to Glasgow, visited the Kelvingrove Art Gallery, and finally the Riverside Museum of Transport which was the European Museum of the year.

On Friday, we drove through Edinburgh seeing sights such as John Knox's house, Greyfriars, George Heriot's School (Hogwarts), and the Church of the Holy Rude. We finished with a detailed tour of Edinburgh Castle and had the rest of the afternoon on our own.

The final day, Saturday, was a free day for everyone to enjoy Edinburgh's many museums, galleries, and shops on their own.

They groom 29% of their total terrain daily (that's 600 acres of groomed trails/day!) and have snowmaking on 600 acres! New to skiing? Green circle trails are generally wide and groomed and account for 11% of the area. Ready to step it up? Intermediate slopes (31% of area) are usually groomed and black diamond slopes (24% of area) are steeper and may or may not be groomed. Double blacks (34% of area) are for expert skiers only. Space is still available! Sign up now. You won't be disappointed.
