Winterize Your Eyes!

As winter enthusiasts we look forward to skiing down the slopes, but winter weather can create its own set of risks to our eyesight and general health of our eyes.

Learn how to be aware of potential eye injuries from the sun, including sun burning sensitive tissues of the eyeball, snow blindness or solar/ultraviolet keratitis, corneal freezing, eye lash freezing, and infection. Learn how to protect our eyes from the cold and sunlight and also how to avoid Seasonal Affective Disorder [SAD].

Our special guest speaker will be Dr. Mahsa Salehi, who is an instructor of ophthalmology at the Wilmer Eye Institute of Johns Hopkins School of Medicine. She received her Doctor of Optometry degree from Salus University in Pennsylvania and completed her optometry residency in primary eye care and ocular disease.

Dr. Salehi will advise us how to take precautions during winter months that can preserve our vision so that we will enjoy the beauty on the slopes for many seasons to come.

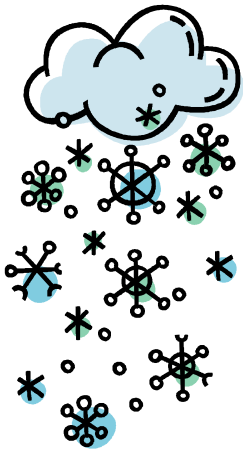

The second annual national Bring a Friend Challenge for snow sports features thousands of dollars in prizes for skiers and snowboarders who help newcomers sign up for lessons from professional instructors. Prizes include trips to the Topnotch Resort in Vermont and trips to all three U.S. Winter Olympics host sites – Lake Placid, Squaw Valley and Salt Lake City (and nearby resorts).

Product prizes range from accessories to skis and snowboards from Armada, Burton, Dynastar, Echelon Snowboards, Flow Snowboards, Head, Lange, RAMP, Rossignol, The North Face, White Sierra, Zeal Optics and others.

What Else is Happening In North America's Ski Industry?

Steamboat Ski Resort has added night skiing on 1,100 vertical feet of Christie Parkway on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday nights from 5:30 to 8:30. Cost is \$29 per night (\$20 when prepaid).

Alyeska Resort is replacing their 25-year-old chair number six with a new \$6 million, high-speed detachable quad chairlift this summer.

June Mountain will reopen in December after being closed for a year. It will continue to target families and entry-level skiers and boarders.

Whistler is replacing Harmony Mountain's high-speed quad with a six-pack, Harmony 6, which will service terrain from the edge of the Symphony Amphitheater to Glacier Bowl, adjacent to the Peak Express. **Blackcomb Mountain** will replace its current fixed-grip triple chair with a new quad in the Crystal Zone. Construction begins this spring with completion expected in time for the beginning of the 2013-14 season.

Pats Peak ski area (New Hampshire) has installed a new triple chairlift into their Cascade Basin -- a new gladed ski area with four ski trails and full snowmaking -- which will be partly powered by green energy including a new geothermal energy heating system in the base lodge.

Windham Mountain in New York has added four acres of beginners' terrain serviced by two new conveyor lifts.

Sunday River Resort (Maine) announced that it has added 75 acres of terrain, becoming the second largest mountain resort in New England (behind Sugarloaf), with a total of 820 acres. Included in the new terrain is a 15-acre terrain park trail, and five new gladed areas -- all of which are set to open for the 2013-14 season.

Use the light cap to wear during the warmer season and the black cap for when it's cooler out. Either way these caps are a great value at only \$8.00.

Big Sky, Moonlight Basin, and Spanish Peaks Combine

Resorts Purchased by Boyne Resorts and CrossHarbor Capital Partners

CrossHarbor Capital Partners LLC, owner of Montana's private Yellowstone Club, and Boyne Resorts, owner of Big Sky, purchased the adjacent Moonlight Basin Resort from Lehman Brothers. This agreement closely followed the acquisition of the Spanish Peaks by the same partnership. Spanish Peaks is a private ski development with 207 acres of terrain and 13 runs, serviced by three lifts which is also adjacent to Big Sky. This move was described by the buyers as the first step in the creation of what will become one of the largest ski resorts in North America. CrossHarbor and Boyne plan to combine the ski operations of Big Sky Resort, Moonlight Basin, and Spanish Peaks to create a ski resort that will have more than 5,700 acres of ski terrain, with 4,350 vertical feet, served by 23 chairlifts and 10 surface lifts. It's also adjacent to CrossHarbor Capital Partners' 13,600-acre private Yellowstone Club ski resort.

Moonlight Basin's problems began in 2008 when Lehman Brothers demanded that the resort repay its \$170 million dollar loan in full several months after Lehman's bankruptcy. A year later, Lehman foreclosed on the loan and Moonlight Basin filed for bankruptcy. In January 2012, Lehman bought Moonlight out of bankruptcy, stating that it would search for a buyer. The Club at Spanish Peaks filed Chapter 7 bankruptcy in 2011. Last season, Big Sky reported a record 370,000 skier days and the *National Ski Club Newsletter* survey reported that they hosted 4% of all U.S. ski club trips.

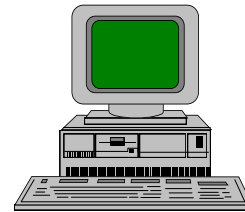
