PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

What a GREAT 70th anniversary party we had in April. Thanks to everyone who worked to put this together. If you missed it, don't worry, I think the committee is planning some other events. At the dinner were former BSC presidents and many former members reminiscing about past trips, old friends, and the state of the ski industry today. Everyone enjoyed the slide show presentation that portrayed some current members at an early age. My thanks to all who sent me pictures for the slide show, especially former president, Richard Weatherby.

While 2017 marks the 70th anniversary of our club (the BSC was incorporated in 1947), our roots go back much further. The Baltimore Ski Club actually began as an off-shoot of the Mountain Club of Maryland (still exists today) which was founded in 1934 and was itself an off-shoot of the Potomac Appalachian Trail Club. Research shows members of the Mountain Club started carrying skis with them during their winter hikes. In 1939, these members actively planned "ski" trips and decided to call themselves the Baltimore Ski Club; however, they were still part of the Mountain Club. World War II curtailed activities of the clubs because most people were busy with the war effort, the young men enlisted, and because gasoline was rationed and transportation was difficult. After the war, members came together again and in 1947 the Baltimore Ski Club was incorporated.

The Baltimore Ski Club was the only ski club in the state of Maryland so they decided to join the Pennsylvania Ski Federation with other Pennsylvania ski clubs. More ski clubs started organizing as soldiers, having learned to ski in Europe, returned to the United States. The BSC, along with the Washington Ski Club, helped form the Blue Ridge Ski Council.

During the rest of this year, I'll be writing period pieces of our club history in this newsletter. (I am also the unofficial club historian.) Did you know Howard Head was once a BSC member? Do you know who Howard Head was?

While the club is celebrating its 70th anniversary, I'm celebrating my 30th year as a member. To mark this occasion and for some of our long-time members, this newsletter will show our trip schedule for 1987, the first year I went on a trip (Greek Peak) with the BSC. Please do not confuse this with our 2018 trip schedule that will also be in this newsletter.

Coming in May is our first summer meeting at Glory Days Grill. Hope to see you there. Mike

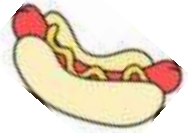

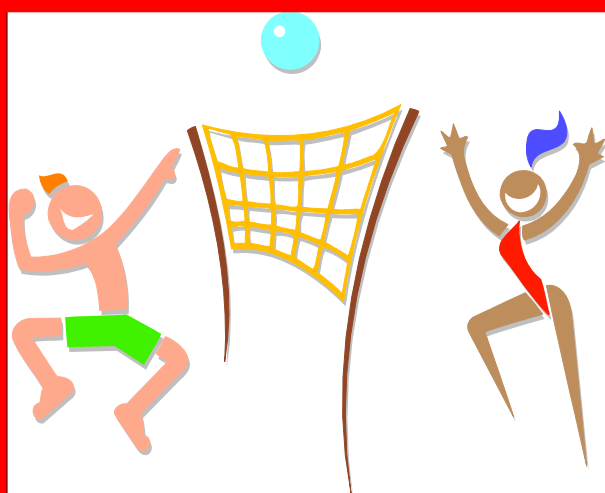

ALL PRICES ARE ESTIMATED: All trips are subject to price adjustments due to potential airline fuel surcharge, increased security fees and airline ticket price fluctuations. Minimum trip deposits are \$250 for all trips.

BSC Trips Cancellation Policy

1. The Club does not intend to unduly penalize a trip participant who cancels from a BSC trip. However, other trip participants should not have to incur additional costs due to your cancellation.
2. Deposits and payments made toward the trip reservations being cancelled will be held until such time as a determination can be made that the Club or trip participants will not incur additional costs due to non-recoverable costs.
3. Non-recoverable costs are defined as those that are associated with the trip that due to contractual obligations cannot be recovered when the individual cancels his/her trip. Non-recoverable also include those costs associated with replacing a person or persons on a trip (i.e., name change charges on airline tickets, etc.) Refunds, if any, will be made based on the non-recoverable involved plus a cancellation fee. Cancellation costs will not exceed the cost of the trip. Club cancellation fee will be dropped if non-recoverable costs exceed 50% of the trip cost.
4. Replacement of a trip participant by a trip participant is strictly prohibited. Only the Trip Leader or Assistant Trip Leader can replace a trip participant who is unable to go on the trip. The canceling trip participant may suggest a replacement candidate to the trip leader or assistant trip leader, however the canceling trip participant is responsible for the cancellation fee (if applicable) and any non-recoverable costs.
5. Be sure to know the cancellation dates in relation to the trip you select so that you can avoid monetary losses. The following cancellation policy is in effect in relation to BSC trips. NR=Non-recoverable costs

More than 125 days before departure - \$0
More than 110 days before departure - \$10 & NR

More than 80 days before departure - \$25 & NR
80 days or less before departure - \$35 & NR
